The Cape Symphony is one of the fastest growing and largest budgeted orchestras in the region. At the Cape Symphony, our mission is to "Inspire Joy."

The Cape Symphony is a per-service orchestra. Section rate for 2021–22 was \$121.34 per service; new rates will increase based on current negotiations. For the 2022–23 season, there will be 5 Masterpiece concerts with 4 rehearsals and 2 concerts each, 4 Pops concerts with 1–2 rehearsals and 2–6 concerts each, 2 educational programs, a New Year's Day concert, and other special events throughout the year, including summer programs. Qualified candidates must be eligible to work in the U.S. The winning candidate may become a tenured member after a probationary period.
